Greg's work with neighbors in Enderly Park focuses on building from their gifts, creating economic opportunity, and combating serial displacement and land loss in a rapidly changing neighborhood. Greg can also be found around Charlotte playing

saxophone. He regularly performs in concert and club venues across North and South Carolina in jazz, classical, and commercial settings. Copies of Greg's book are available today for \$15 each.
